Responsibilities:

- Pick and prepare orders

- Accurately record information for product received both manually and using RF. Note any discrepancies.
- Retrieve orders according to quantity, size etc. ensuring accuracy, meet deadlines and adhere to the picking standards.
- Prioritize work with the Team Leader according to date received, cancel dates, rushes and special orders as requested to ensure they are fulfilled on time
- Understand non-routine notes and instructions attached to orders
- Picker are responsible for an aisle to request daily refilling of bins
- Able to work independently or in group settings in a fast paced environment
- Clean up warehouse ensure area is kept free of garbage, wood, empty pallets, wrap, etc.
- Check incoming pick tickets
- Locate products using scanner
- Build box(s) with orders and position them to loading docks
- Adhere to health & safety policies and quality standards
- Assist in counting of physical inventory and verifying stock and identifying losses.
- Clean work area daily, keep work area neat and organized at all times
- Any other duties as directed by their supervisor.
